# Virtual Reality (VR) vs Augmented Reality (AR)

The key distinction between VR and AR is that VR is meant to immerse the user in a virtual environment, while AR introduces virtual elements onto the real world.

- Virtual reality (VR) is an artificial, computer-generated simulation or recreation of a real life environment or situation. It lets the user feel like they are experiencing the simulated reality firsthand, primarily by stimulating their vision and hearing through wearing a headset.
